There were 72 reported incidents in October.

Incidents of note:

Assault

Two members of staff at McDonalds were assaulted by an unknown individual. One person was assaulted as a result of a domestic argument and three others were assaulted at a local establishment.

Dwelling Burglary

There was one dwelling burglary this month at a property in Minstead. Wooden doors were forced and five bikes were stolen from a garage annexe. This was classed as a dwelling burglary as the annexe has bedrooms and can be used as a dwelling if needed.

Burglary – non dwelling

There were two non dwelling burglaries in the Minstead area in October. Several sheds on one property were forced and garden machinery, including a ride on lawn mower, were stolen during one afternoon.

The other property targeted in Minstead had a garage broken into and a lawn mower stolen.

Thefts from motor vehicles

Vehicles were broken into in the areas of Newbridge, Roundhill, Blackhill Road, Winsor Road and Busketts Lawn. All of the incidents this month involved windows being smashed and handbags or other valuables being taken.

Please remove all valuables from your vehicle when leaving it unattended. Thieves are waiting and watching people leaving

their vehicles. The message is simple: if it's not left in the car, it can't be stolen!

Theft

Keys left on a post at Fritham were found to be missing when the owner returned to collect them.

A large amount of apples were stolen from trees in an privately owned orchard at Minstead and five fir trees have been uprooted and stolen from Loperwood Lane. A person has been arrested for theft of cash and is currently being dealt with by police.

Road Traffic Incidents (RTIs)

There were three 'animal injury' road traffic incidents on the B3079, the B3078 and on Copythorne Road in Ower.

There were five 'damage only' RTIs. Four of these were on the M27 and one was at Tatchbury Lane.

Finally, there were also three RTIs resulting in minor injuries. Two of these were on the A36 and one was on Winsor Road in Winsor.
