



During the public participation session, local residents addressed the Council on the unauthorised landfill operations adjacent to Copperfield, Pollards Moor Road. Residents expressed concern at the increased scale of the operations and sought action to stop further site activities pending determination of the recent planning application. The Parish Council was asked to hold a public meeting to allow residents to discuss the various issues involved and to invite representatives of the relevant authorities to attend, including the New Forest National Park Authority, the Environment Agency and Hampshire County Council. County and District Councillors and the local MP should also be invited. It was agreed to arrange the meeting for Thursday 23 November at 7 pm at a suitable available venue (Parish Hall, Scout Hut or the Royal British Legion hall) (subsequently agreed for 8 pm at the Scout Hut).

Residents had arranged a meeting with the local press for 9.30 am on Wednesday 15 November and representation from the Parish Council would be welcome.
