**82. PLANNING MATTERS**

*(a) Current applications:* Members agreed to comment as follows on current planning applications:

- 07/92058      The Hazels, Winsor Lane, Winsor (Conservatory). Support (3)
- 07/92103      Copperfields, Pollards Moor Road (Importation of material and raising of level of land to improve land drainage (part retrospective)). Object (4).
- 07/92106      Broom Hill, Winsor Road, Winsor (Rear extension). Support (1), provided the development complies with the 30% rule
- 07/92118      Field onto Shepherds Road, Bartley (Form new field access). Support (3), provided the gate measures 3 metres and not 9 metres as stated in the design statement

*(b) Application 07/90829 – The Old Brickyard, Salisbury Road, East Wellow – Lawful Development Certificate:* This application was for use of land for parking, office and storage use ancillary to scaffolding operations. Part of the site had received a certificate under application 04/80433 but a certificate had been refused for the remainder. The Council had previously offered no comment on the present application but had been asked to reconsider the position as a nearby resident claimed that the area for which permission was sought had been used for less than the statutory period of ten years. However, it was agreed that the Council was unable to comment as members did not have personal knowledge of the site.

*(c) Applications referred to Committee:* The following applications were being considered by the National Park Planning Committee on 16 October 2007:

*(d) Enforcement:* Mobile home and letter box installed on land off A36 towards Ower roundabout.

**83. VILLAGE 30 PROGRAMME**

Members received a report on a meeting with Mott Gifford on 27 September, attended by Councillor John Samways and the Clerk. The proposal to convert the 40 mph limit in Winsor Road to 30 mph generally complied with the necessary criteria. If adopted, consideration could also be given to 40 mph limits in Pound Lane and Barrow Hill Road and for the section of Romsey Road past The Empress of Blandings.

Optional signing was available for the new Winsor Road speed limit. Members agreed the following:

- sign near Whitemoor junction to have 'Winsor' added
- red 30 mph road markings to be added at Whitemoor Lane end

**84. TRAFFIC SPEED IN BARTLEY**

Residents of Bartley had presented a petition requesting a 30 mph speed limit on residential roads in Bartley together with traffic calming measures to aid reinforcement. Agreed, Parish Council to submit request in the next stage of the Village 30 programme.

**85. FUTURE LEADER FUNDING IN THE NEW FOREST**

A letter from the National Park Authority invited organisations to attend a Sustainable Communities Workshop on Monday 15 October 2007 at Lyndhurst Community Centre. No member was able to attend.

**86. NFDC LIAISON MEETING**

Councillor Stenson reported on the recent liaison meeting at Lyndhurst. The following items were of particular note:

- presentation by Hampshire Police Authority. Police attach low priority to car break-ins. Of 30 police in the area, four on full time sick leave.
- discussion on condition of footpaths. Several parishes experiencing similar problems.
