121. PLANNING MATTERS

(a) Current applications: Members agreed to comment as follows on current planning applications:

- (a) Samaritans:* Grant request from the Southampton & District Samaritans. Agreed, decline.
- (b) Copythorne Pre-School:* Enquiry concerning the possibility of publicity on the parish web site. Agreed, consider further when the site is fully operational.
- (c) Claimed byway, Cadnam Common (114(a)/2/07):* Following the Parish Council's letter to Newbridge properties, a resident had written to Rights of Way objecting to the claim.
- (d) Highway tour:* Agreed, arrange for Thursday 29 March at 9 am (from Parish Hall).
- (e) Foxbury Plantation:* First phase of the tree felling operation due to start at the end of March. Work to be carried out by forestry contractors on behalf of the Longford Estate, who own the timber rights. Once the first phase is complete, the National Trust will start restoration work, which will include rhododendron removal.
- (f) Fly-tipping:* Rubbish dumped in Barrow Hill Road. Agreed, request NFDC to remove.
- (g) Newbridge Road:* Caravan in field between Newbridge Road and Romsey Road. Agreed, refer to Enforcement.
