**65. PLANNING MATTERS**

*(a) Current applications:* Members agreed to comment as follows on current planning applications:

- 07/91913 Harvest Moon, Winsor Road, Winsor (Variation of condition 2 of permission 64425 to allow retention of loft conversion). Object (4)
- 07/91915 Harvest Moon, Winsor Road, Winsor (Relief from condition 2 on permission 64741 to allow stabling of horses). Defer in the absence of a briefing note.
- 07/91922 Sylvana, White Hart Lane, Cadnam (House and garage; demolish existing dwelling). Object (4)
- 07/91948 Poona Lodge, Old Romsey Road, Cadnam (Dwelling; access; demolish existing dwelling). Support (3).

*(c) Enforcement:* Field shelter, Barrow Hill Road: The NFNPA had now identified that the shelter was on skids and was not in breach of planning control provided the structure was moved periodically.

The Yews, Southampton Road, Cadnam: The hard surface recently constructed would require inspection to determine whether any planning breach had occurred. This would be assessed when other outstanding issues, including signage matters, were considered.

**66. SPLITWIND POND**

The site required routine maintenance, as identified at the recent quarterly inspection. Noted that the Chairman has agreed to carry out strimming as soon as possible.

**67. FOOTPATH MAINTENANCE**

A note from the Rights of Way Officer commented on the limited resources for footpath maintenance. While works orders had been issued for signpost repairs, the current priority was clearance work which was several months behind schedule because of weather conditions. It was hoped that the outstanding work to Copythorne signposts could be carried out during the week of 10 – 14 September.

It was agreed to copy the note to County and District Councillors for Copythorne to underline the unsatisfactory situation regarding resources for footpath maintenance.
