36. DECLARATION OF INTERESTS

37. PLANNING MATTERS

New application: Members agreed the following responses to current applications:

CONS/12/ James Farm, Winsor Road, Winsor (Felling of willow tree). No objection
0216 (Councillor Reilly declared a non-pecuniary interest in this application)

Decisions: Members noted recent decisions as shown in the list tabled at the meeting (appendix 1 in the minute book). The list included an application referred to the NPA Planning Committee on 17 July (12/97446, Warrawee Duck Farm, Pollards Moor Road). Agreed, Chairman to attend and speak on this item.

Land adjacent to Copperfield, Pollards Moor Road: Members noted the officers' report to the NPA Planning Committee on 17 July on this topic, together with Steve Avery's e-mail of 5 July containing responses to Parish Council queries following the Ramboll report. Members discussed various aspects of the report and the Chairman outlined the main points of his proposed presentation to the Planning Committee.
