144. PLANNING MATTERS

New applications: Members agreed the following responses to current applications:

- 11/97007 Kingsbridge House, Southampton Road, Cadnam (Outbuilding (demolition of existing building)). Support (3)
- 11/97067 Yew Tree Cottage, Winsor Road, Winsor (Extension of porch/utility room; new roof to garage with raised roof pitch). Object (4)
- 12/97100 The Vine Inn, Romsey Road, Ower (Retention of 1 no. internally illuminated post sign; 3 no. internally illuminated wall signs; 1 no. externally illuminated wall sign; 1 no. non-illuminated post sign; 1 no lantern (Application for advertisement consent). Object (4)
- 12/97117 The Moorings, Barrow Hill Road, Copythorne. (Proposed single storey first floor and 2 two storey extensions). Support (3)
 (The applicant spoke in support of the application)
- 12/98221 Stretton, Whinwhistle Road, East Wellow (single-storey rear extension). Object (4)
- SFLA/12/0032 Green Lane, Bartley (Forestry Commission tree felling). No objection

Decisions etc: Members noted recent decisions and a new appeal, as shown in the list accompanying the agenda (appendix 1 in the minute book). The following application was also to be considered by the NPA Planning Committee with a recommendation for refusal (the Parish Council had recommended approval): 11/97061 (Part parcel OS 0400, field opposite Langton Cottage, Winsor Road (Retention of current structure for use as tack store etc)).

Copperfield, Pollards Moor Road: The Clerk tabled a response from Steve Avery in response to the drainage questions posed to the NPA following the last meeting. These were addressed in part but the majority were awaiting a response from the landowner's consultant. Members also had sight of the officers' report to the Planning Committee meeting scheduled for 21 February which recommended completion of the section 106 agreement, subject to consideration of the questions posed by the Parish Council.

Local residents again expressed concern that the drainage issues were not being adequately addressed, in particular the displacement of ground water. The ditch adjoining the Copperfield site also appeared polluted and required the urgent attention of the Environment Agency. The residents also presented a letter written by Dr Julian Lewis MP to Alison Barnes containing matters to be addressed at the forthcoming Planning meeting.

It was agreed that the Chairman would represent the Parish Council at the Planning meeting on 21 February. The Clerk would also press the NPA to obtain a response from the Environment Agency on the contents of the roadside ditch.

145. COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT GRANTS

Councillors Puttock and Tipp each had £166 available to Copythorne parish in 2011/12 for a suitable community project. Agreed that grant applications be made in respect of the forthcoming Diamond Jubilee celebrations.

146. LOCALISM ACT

Parish Councils were invited to a presentation by Dave Yates and Steve Avery on Thursday 1 March 2012 at 6.30 pm at Appletree Court, Lyndhurst on the provisions of the Localism Act. Agreed, Chairman, Councillor Goodwin and Clerk to attend.

147. THE QUEEN'S 2012 DIAMOND JUBILEE

Members would receive a presentation from Councillor Goodwin at the next meeting on the proposed Jubilee celebrations. Publicity arrangements would also be discussed. Reference was also made to an approach from the Ancient Order of Foresters concerning commemorate tree planting which would be referred to the next Jubilee Group meeting.

148. NO COLD CALLING

Councillor Goodwin wished to display No Cold Calling signs for Bartley on the Council's notice board opposite Bartley Post Office. Agreed, provided no damage is caused to the notice board.
