FOOTPATH INSPECTIONS – Sarah Coombs

FOOTPATH 4

October 2017

An old but clearly visible footpath sign leads you across the motorway bridge, (Photo A), at the end of this another footpath sign leads you left along a part tarmac drive, (B) before entering the boundary of the house along this track turn right at the foot path sign and go over a stile. (C). The path then travels into woodland, but is a clear path to follow. After following this track for a while you need to bear right – this isn't sign posted. (D) This then in turn takes you to the gravel track with various footpath signs. Cross the track and enter the wooded area after the stile. Travel straight through wood area and exit on to narrow pathway again across stile.(E) Follow pathway until you come to the road. The pathway is clear, a little hilly. There is no footpath sign at the road end. (F) This walk can be wet and muddy in places.



Footpath 5

Date Inspected:- Sunday 8th Oct 2017

Weather on day of inspection:- Dry, sunny.

From Pollards Moor Road head up Vicarage Lane, this part is new tarmac, the footpath then heads on to a private gravel track with many pot holes. This leads to a gateway there is a footpath sign. Broken fencing needs mending at this gate. (1)

The path way has recently been cut (I have known this track to be over grown but still passable!!). (2)

At the end of the track is another gateway. (3) Go through this, follow path which opens out into the scout hut field, (4) follow the left hand side of this open area, along buildings and exit out via gateway.

This footpath is clear and well maintained, no work needs to be carried out.









Footpath 6

Date Inspected:- Sunday 8th Oct 2017

Weather on day of inspection:- Dry, Sunny.

Carrying on from footpath 5 where it opens out onto the scout field, (3) travel across the field following the boundary fence, at arriving at the school grounds a foot path sign takes you across a stile. (4). Follow the field fence line and this will take you out onto Pound Lane. A stile and footpath sign show entry and exit. (5) This footpath can be wet and muddy.

This footpath is clear, no maintenance is required.
