

## COPYTHORNE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING TUESDAY NOVEMBER 12TH 2019

### Item 19. Correspondence & Clerks Report

1. Paperless Office Update – Unfortunately, pressures relating to dealing with other items and my holiday for a week at the end of October have meant that I have not be able to allocate sufficient time to commence the “roll-out” of the Samsung Tablets. This will be scheduled for the later this month.
2. Letter received from New Forest Disability on October 10<sup>th</sup> thanking us for the £150 Grant awarded to them by the Parish Council.
3. On October 17<sup>th</sup> 2019 I attended (along with Cllr Lucas) a briefing meeting at Appletree Court on the upcoming NFDC Electoral Boundary Review. A copy of the presentation from a representative of the Local Government Boundary Commission for England was circulated to all councillors on October 18<sup>th</sup>. Initial information relating to the review is included in our latest Newsletter and background information has been placed on our website ([www.copythorne.org.uk/nfdc-electoral-review/](http://www.copythorne.org.uk/nfdc-electoral-review/)). The review is open for initial consultation from November 26 2019 to February 3 2020. The review and discussion of our response to it will be an agenda item for our meeting on December 10.
4. On Oct 21 2019 I circulated to all councillors a copy of the notes made by Cllr. John Goodwin (and accompanying documents) from an NFNPA Planning Agents meeting which he attended on October 9<sup>th</sup> in a personal capacity.
5. At our October meeting, I reported that an anonymous letter has been received suggesting that Footpath 5 (Romsey Road to Vicarage Lane) does not follow the route shown on the Definitive Map through the Scout Hut field. Whilst I have no way of contacting the writer I have checked the Definitive Map and I am happy that it is still possible to follow the route of Footpaths 5 and 6 as shown on the Definitive Map and waymarked on the ground without deviation.
6. On November 15<sup>th</sup> I will be meeting with PCSO Richard Williams at Lyndhurst Police Station to be briefed on a new system called “Safety Net”. I understand that this system shares information with the police and partner agencies. I will report back to Council in due course.
