

## FOOTPATH INSPECTIONS – PATHS 5 , 6 AND 12 – WALKED BY SYLVIA WIGGINS, SEPT 2019

### PATH 5 – Vicarage Lane to Romsey Road (behind rear of St Mary’s Church)

Path - the start of which at junction of Pollards Moor Road/Vicarage Lane is marked by a finger post(1) - runs west to east, initially along Vicarage Lane (tarmac surface) then through a “kissing gate(2) onto a wide earth track with barbed wire fence on both sides. Overgrowing vegetation has recently been cut. Track runs behind St Mary’s Church to another kissing gate(3) and then heads north through the field alongside Copythorne Scout Hut to a gate into the car park(4) and then eventually to Romsey Road.

### PATH 6 – Copythorne Scout Hall Field to Pound Lane

Path starts at the southwest corner of the Scout Hall field marked by a Right of Way post(1) and then heads in a north easterly direction along a fence line to behind Copythorne Infants School. Then cross a stile(2) and walk in an eastern direction(3) along the field edge to come out via another stile onto Pound Lane(4). Full length of path is along edges of fields on good ground. Signage at either end (with the exception of the “finger” at Pound Lane end) is in good order, as are both stiles.

### PATH 12 – Newbridge Road to Romsey Road



Path which is marked by a finger post (which needs re-aligning and the finger replaced) starts a little way north of the Newbridge Road/Romsey Road crossroads and is accessed via stile (which was partly covered by brambles and nettles). Path then heads along the northern edge of a field before passing through a gate into another field. It then heads broadly south east across that field to arrive at a stile providing access onto Romsey Road. A finger post marks the access point. Both the stile (which had a degree of vegetation covering it) and the finger post are in good order.
