

COPYTHORNE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING - TUESDAY JUNE 8TH 2021

Item 11 – To nominate a Parish Council representative to sit on the Platinum Jubilee Celebrations Working Party

Background

At the April 13th 2021 Council meeting a discussion took place regarding the Queen's Platinum Jubilee in June 2022 and the response to that event within the Parish.

Subsequent to that discussion the Parish Hall Committee, through their representatives, Barbara Smith and Joy Vallis have taken the lead in setting up a "working party" to co-ordinate plans and arrangements since the events will be centred around Copythorne Parish Hall, and any funds raised will be contributed to the proposed new extension building fund.

Action required

The "Working Party" has asked the Parish Council to nominate a Parish Councillor to join it.

Voting

Voting on the Parish Council representative will be in accordance with Standing Order 8 (Voting on Appointments).

- a. Where more than two persons have been nominated for a position to be filled by the Council and none of those persons has received an absolute majority of votes in their favour, the name of the person having the least number of votes shall be struck off the list and a fresh vote taken. This process shall continue until a majority of votes is given in favour of one person. A tie in votes may be settled by the casting vote exercisable by the chairman of the meeting.

Next Steps

Once the representative has been chosen the role I will arrange for the details to be added to the list of "Parish Council Representatives on external bodies" on our website and notified the "Working Party"
